ASSESSMENT			
Clinical indication clearly documented			
Alternatives to restraint/seclusion documented (less restrictive)			
PATIENT MONITORING

A physician or LP responsible for the patient's care orders the			
restraint

Orders are renewed as authorized with indication for continuation

STAFF TRAINING			
Staff are trained in all requirements including alternatives to
